The following House Files were introduced:

Mekeland introduced:

H. F. No. 2918, A bill for an act relating to economic development; appropriating money for public infrastructure for a business park in Becker.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Franson introduced:

H. F. No. 2919, A bill for an act relating to commerce; consumer protection; prohibiting an adjuster or insurer from certain actions relating to motor vehicle repairs and claims; amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, sections 72A.201, subdivision 6; 72B.092, subdivision 1.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

Morrison and Zerwas introduced:

H. F. No. 2920, A bill for an act relating to health; modifying the Minnesota Athletic Trainers Act; amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, sections 148.7802, by adding a subdivision; 148.7806; 148.7807; repealing Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 148.7802, subdivisions 4, 5.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Health and Human Services Policy.

Drazkowski, Munson, Bahr and Miller introduced:

H. F. No. 2921, A bill for an act relating to state government finance; appropriating money to continue operations of a state agency if a bill to fund the operations of that agency has not been enacted by July 1, 2019.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
