Summary

Government entities may respond to larger or more complex public data requests on a rolling basis over a period of time, rather than all at once. This bill provides that a government entity may suspend an ongoing response to a public data request if the requesting person does not appear to inspect requested data or collect copies of requested data that the government entity has already prepared for that person.
