

LEO'S STORY

Born: 2016 Diagnosis: Infantile Pompe disease

Leo's diagnosis causes weakness and deterioration of muscles, respiratory failure, and cardiomyopathy. The early prognosis was that he would be on long-term trach care, unable to sit up on his own, and would need 24-hour nursing.

PHS has provided weekly infusion nursing, equipment & supplies, and support from a respiratory therapist and despite challenges that Pompe disease brings, Leo is thriving at home with PHS. He no longer requires a vent and has been decannulated, and now plays floor hockey in his wheelchair at school with the other kids.
