Re: Legal Aid/Minnesota Disability Law Center Support for HF 666

Dear Co-Chair Noor, Co-Chair Schomacker, and Members of the Committee:

Legal Aid and the Minnesota Disability Law Center (MDLC) thank you for the opportunity to provide written testimony regarding HF 666.

Medical Assistance for Employed Persons with Disabilities (MA-EPD) is an important yet difficult program for participants. Home and Community-Based Services like Community First Services and Supports (CFFS) and disability waivers are not covered by the majority of employer-sponsored plans. Consequently, even if a person with a disability receives health care benefits through their employers, they will often be without necessary care. MA-EPD allows individuals with disabilities to work while still receiving essential supports. However, due to complex program requirements, premiums, and income limits, MA-EPD participants often experience billing issues and difficulties paying premiums.

Prohibiting termination from the program based on the nonpayment of premiums would allow participants to continue to remain on MA-EPD while working out billing issues and financial difficulties. This bill will allow MA-EPD participants to remain employed without disruption to their essential services.

Thank you for the opportunity to submit written testimony regarding HF 666. We urge you to support this bill.
