Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 122A.73, subdivision 2, is amended to read: 2.7 Subd. 2. Grow Your Own district programs. (a) A school district, charter school, 2.8 Tribal contract school, or cooperative unit under section 123A.24, subdivision 2, and all 2.9 teacher preparation programs approved by the Professional Educator Licensing and Standards 2.10 Board may apply for a grant for a teacher preparation program that meets the requirements 2.11 of paragraph (c) to establish a Grow Your Own pathway for adults to obtain their first 2.12 professional teaching license. The grant recipient must use at least 80 percent of grant funds 2.13 to provide tuition scholarships or stipends to enable grant recipient employees or community 2.14 members affiliated with a grant recipient, who are of color or American Indian and who 2.15 2.16 seek a teaching license, to participate in the teacher preparation program. Grant funds may also be used to pay for teacher licensure exams and licensure fees. 2.17 2.18 (b) A district using grant funds under this subdivision to provide financial support to teacher candidates may require a commitment as determined by the district to teach in the 2.19 school district, charter school, Tribal contract school, or cooperative unit for a reasonable 2.20 amount of time that does not exceed five years. 2.21 (c) A grantee must partner with: 2.22 (1) a Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board-approved teacher preparation 2.23 program; 2.24 (2) a Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation-accredited teacher preparation 2.25 program from a private, not for profit, institution of higher education; or 2.26 (3) an institution that has an articulated transfer pathway with a board-approved teacher 2.27 preparation program. 2.28 (d) Teacher preparation programs approved by the Professional Educator Licensing and 2.29 Standards Board are deemed eligible for all grant funds available under this section. 2.30 EFFECTIVE DATE.
