1.14	13.2. The fiscal calendar established under House Rule 1.22 is not in effect.
1.15	13.3. If a question of germaneness is raised under House Rule 3.21 and the question is put to
1.16	the body, or if a decision of the presiding officer under House Rule 3.21 is appealed, the affirmative
1.17	vote of at least one member of each caucus is required to find the motion or proposition germane.
1.18	13.4. The following motions may only be approved by the House by the affirmative vote of at
1.19	least 68 members:
1.20	to adjourn sine die; and
1.21	to take a bill from the table.
1.22	13.5. A resolution to vacate the office of Speaker may only be approved by the House by the
1.23	affirmative vote of at least 68 members.
