

**Subject** Reduced board of managers; Crane Lake Water and Sanitary District

## Summary

This bill authorizes the number of members of the Crane Lake Water and Sanitary District to be reduced from five to three members, upon approval by the governing body. Under current law, a sanitary district created under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 442A, has five members.

To transition to a board of three managers, vacancies on the board would not be filled until the number of managers has been appropriately reduced. Once the board of managers has three members, staggered terms would be established for the members.

The bill is effective the day after the governing body of the Crane Lake Water and Sanitary District complies with the requirements for special laws.
