1.3 "Section 1. ADDITION TO STATE PARK.

1.4 [85.012] [Subd. 11] Carley State Park, Wabasha County. The following area is added
 1.5 to Carley State Park: That part of Section 32, Township 108 North, Range 11 West, Wabasha
 1.6 County, Minnesota, described as follows: Beginning at the South Quarter corner stake of
 1.7 said Section 32; thence North 15-1/2 degrees East along road 425 feet; thence North 17
 1.8 degrees East 290 feet; thence North 53 degrees East 280 feet; thence North 17 degrees East
 1.9 115 feet; thence North 6-1/2 degrees West 643 feet; thence North 72-1/2 degrees West 720
 1.10 feet; thence North across river 690 feet; thence South 62 degrees East 263 feet along northerly
 1.11 bank of river; thence North 250 feet to center of said Section 32; thence East 1,320 feet;

3.5 (b) The conveyance must be in a form approved by the attorney general. The attorney
3.6 general may make changes to the land description to correct errors and ensure accuracy.

3.8 the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter, Section 15, Township 59 North, Range 24

3.25 private sale the tax-forfeited land bordering public water that is described in paragraph (c),
3.26 under the remaining provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 282.

3.27 (b) The conveyance must be in a form approved by the attorney general. The attorney
3.28 general may make changes to the land description to correct errors and ensure accuracy.

4.14 general may make changes to the land description to correct errors and ensure accuracy.

4.15 (c) The land to be sold is located in St. Louis County and is described as:

4.16 (1) the easterly 15 feet of Lot 5, Block 47, West Duluth 6th Division, Section 7, Township
4.17 49, Range 14 (parcel number 010-4520-06505); and

4.18 (2) that part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter described as follows:
4.19 beginning at the northwest corner continue due East parallel with the north boundary line
4.20 a distance of 330 feet to a point of beginning; thence due South parallel with the west
