

Subject Farmed Cervidae and chronic wasting disease

Summary

If the owner of a herd of farmed Cervidae (deer, elk, moose) detects chronic wasting disease, current law requires that the owner perform certain disease control and notice obligations, including depopulating the premises, maintaining fencing, posting biohazard signs, disclosing to any buyer before selling or transferring the property, and recording a certain form with the county recorder or registrar of titles as notice on the owner's property record.

This bill would eliminate the requirement to record a certain form with the county recorder or registrar of titles.
