

Subject Community supervision funding

Summary

This bill makes changes to the community supervision funding formula by requiring the felony and misdemeanor per diem rates to be multiplied by the three-year average total felony and misdemeanor populations. Under current law the per diem rates are multiplied by the felony and misdemeanor populations as reported in the most recent probation survey.

The bill also appropriates \$12,622,000 in fiscal year 2026 from the general fund to the commissioner of corrections for distribution under the community supervision funding formula. This is an ongoing appropriation.
