1.7 (2) to preserve or protect evidence from the imminent risk of destruction;

1.8 (3) over a public event where there is a heightened risk to the safety of participants or
1.9 bystanders;

1.10 (4) in risk of, or for purposes of, the lawful pursuit of a fleeing suspect;

1.11 ~~(3)~~ (5) to counter the risk of a terrorist attack by a specific individual or organization if
1.12 the agency determines that credible intelligence indicates a risk;

1.13 ~~(4)~~ (6) to prevent the loss of life and property in natural or man-made disasters and to
1.14 facilitate operational planning, rescue, and recovery operations in the aftermath of these
1.15 disasters;

1.16 ~~(5)~~ (7) to conduct a threat assessment in anticipation of a specific event;

1.17 ~~(6)~~ (8) to collect information from a public area if there is reasonable suspicion of criminal
1.18 activity;

1.19 (9) to locate an incarcerated person escaping from an adult correctional facility under
1.20 the control of the commissioner of corrections or licensed by the commissioner of corrections
1.21 under section 241.021;

- 2.2 collision occurring on a public road;
- 2.3 ~~(8)~~ (11) over a private area with the written consent of the occupant or a public area for

- 2.5 ~~(9)~~ (12) for purposes unrelated to law enforcement at the request of a government entity
- 2.6 provided that the government entity makes the request in writing to the law enforcement
