

STREET RECONSTRUCTION FUNDING

Public Purpose

To allow access to approximately 170 acres of land within city limits through the creation of roadways, providing enhanced traffic circulation and opportunities for recreational and much-needed residential development.

City Action

Fairlakes Ave Project: The City is constructing an extension of Fairlakes Ave from Woodland Ave to Lake Ave, connecting the two thoroughfares and opening 75 acres of City of Fairmont land for single- and multiple-family home development. An additional 34 acres of City-owned land in this area could be utilized for recreational and/or cultural amenity purposes. **Charles St Extension & Kot St Project:** This will increase access to 18.5+ acres of R1-zoned land for residential development. It will also provide more entrance/exit points for nearby athletic fields, alleviating traffic congestion issues. Additionally, the new roadway will have design features to assist with motorist and pedestrian safety. The project plan includes a one-mile multipurpose recreational trail as well, which will connect with the community's already established trails to elevate recreational opportunities for residents and visitors alike.

Projected Schedule

May 2025 thru June 2027 for both projects

Cost of Construction/Engineering

\$10.5 M combined total for both projects


