1.3	"Section 1. STATUE REPLACEMENT.
1.4	The commissioner of administration may accept private funds, submit a request to the
1.5	Joint Committee on the Library of Congress, and erect a new statue in Statuary Hall in the
1.6	United States Capitol, including removing an existing statue from Statuary Hall and
1.7	transporting it to Minnesota, recasting an existing statute in Minnesota, and transporting
1.8	and installing the new statue in Statuary Hall. All money accepted by the commissioner
1.9	under this section must be deposited in a dedicated account in the special revenue fund and
1.10	is appropriated to the commissioner for purposes of this section. The account expires on
1.11	January 1, 2028, with any money remaining in the account at that time appropriated to the
1.12	State Arts Board for purposes of the programs and activities authorized under Minnesota
1.13	Statutes, chapter 129D.
1.14	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day after the chief clerk of the house
1.15	of representatives and the secretary of the senate jointly notify the revisor of statutes and

- 1.16 the commissioner of administration that the state has satisfied the requirements for a statue
- 1.17 replacement request under United States Code, title 2, chapter 30, section 2132."
