1.5	Section 1. Laws 2024, chapter 115, article 2, section 21, subdivision 2, is amended to

1.7	Subd. 2. Required health-related subject areas. The commissioner must include the
1.8	following expectations for learning in the statewide standards:
1.9	(1) cardiopulmonary resuscitation and automatic external defibrillator education that
1.10	allows districts to provide instruction to students in grades 7 through 12 in accordance with
1.11	Minnesota Statutes, section 120B.236;
1.12	(2) vaping awareness and prevention education that allows districts to provide instruction
1.13	to students in grades 6 through 8 in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 120B.238,
1.14	subdivision 3;
1.15	(3) cannabis use and substance use education that includes overdose recognition,
1.16	prevention, and response education that allows districts to provide instruction to students
1.17	in grades 6 through 12 in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 120B.215;
1.18	(4) sexually transmitted infections and diseases education that meets the requirements
1.19	of Minnesota Statutes, section 121A.23; and
1.20	(5) mental health education for students in grades 4 through 12.
