Overview

As amended, this bill contains a provision expanding the statutory boundaries of Carley State Park as well as provisions authorizing a number of counties to sell certain tax-forfeited land, including provisions that were originally proposed in H.F. 1191, H.F. 1199, H.F. 1729, and H.F. 2524.

Section	Description
1	Addition to state park. Adds land to the statutory boundaries of Carley State Park.
2	Private sale of tax-forfeited land; Aitken County. Allows Aitkin County to sell certain tax-forfeited lands by private sale (from H.F. 1191).
3	Private sale of tax-forfeited land; Aitken County. Allows Aitkin County to sell certain tax-forfeited lands by private sale (from H.F. 1199).
4	Private sale of tax-forfeited land; Itasca County. Allows Itasca County to sell certain tax-forfeited lands by private sale.
5	Private sale of tax-forfeited land bordering public water; Sibley County. Allows Sibley County to sell certain tax-forfeited lands bordering public water by private sale (from H.F. 2524).
6	Private sale of tax-forfeited land; St. Louis County. Allows St. Louis County to sell certain tax-forfeited lands by private sale (from H.F. 1729).

Section	Description
7	Effective date. States that sections in the bill are effective the day following final enactment.
