## **Overview**

This bill would amend the state's trespass law to allow a person to use purple paint markings to mark land as closed to the public for purposes of outdoor recreation instead of using "no trespassing" signs which must be used under current law.

Provides a definition of "forest land" for purposes of the state's trespass law.

Allows a person to place purple paint marks on trees, posts, or other immovable, permanent objects to mark land as closed to the public for purposes of outdoor recreation. Establishes requirements for the markings including size, location, and distance between marks.
