1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 174.49, subdivision 6, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 6. Metropolitan counties; use of funds. (a) A metropolitan county must use
1.8	funds that are received under subdivision 5 as follows:
1.9	(1) not more than 41.5 percent for active transportation and transportation corridor safety
1.10	studies multimodal purposes as specified in paragraph (b); and
1.11	(2) $41.5$ not less than 58.5 percent for:
1.12	(i) repair, preservation, and rehabilitation of transportation systems; and
1.13	(ii) roadway replacement to reconstruct, reclaim, or modernize a corridor without adding
1.14	traffic capacity, except for auxiliary lanes with a length of less than 2,500 feet; and.
1.15	(3) 17 percent for any of the following:
1.16	(b) A metropolitan county may use the amount under paragraph (a), clause (1), for:
1.17	(1) active transportation;
1.18	(2) transportation corridor safety studies;
1.19	$\frac{(i)}{(3)}$ transit purposes, including but not limited to operations, maintenance, capital
1.20	maintenance, demand response service, and assistance to replacement service providers
1.21	under section 473.388;

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2.1 (ii) (4) complete streets projects, as provided under section 174.75; and

2.2 (iii)(5) projects, programs, or operations activities that meet the requirements of **a** 

2.3 <u>mitigation an offset</u> action under section 161.178, subdivision 4.

- 2.4 (b) Funds under paragraph (a), clause (3), must supplement and not supplant existing
  2.5 sources of revenue.
- 2.6 (c) A metropolitan county may use funds that are received under subdivision 5 as debt
  2.7 service for obligations issued by the county in accordance with chapter 475, provided that
  2.8 the obligations are issued for a use allowable under this section.

## 2.9 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective January 1, 2026, for funds received on 2.10 or after that date.
