

- Advisory committee to the Minnesota Supreme Court
- Governed by court rules and the Judicial Branch Outgoing Grant Management Policy



Effective: July 1, 2025


### State Board of Civil Legal Aid

#### Established by Minnesota Statutes 480.2415



- Standalone agency in the Judicial Branch
- Similar to the State Board of Public Defense and Guardian Ad Litem Board
- Charged with ensuring high-quality legal services in every county
