Overview

This bill repeals a section of law that prohibits using evidence in a case related to whether or not a person used a seat belt or car seat in litigation related to a car accident.

Section Description

1 REPEALER. Seat belt; passenger restraint system for children.

Repeal of the current law that says that, other than in cases related to defective seat belts or car seats, in a car accident lawsuit related to personal or property damage, evidence related to the use of a seat belt or car seat is not admissible.
