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Overview

This bill requires health plans and medical assistance to cover advance care planning services.

Summary

Section Description

1 Coverage of advance care planning services.

Adds § 62Q.547. Requires a health plan that provides coverage to Minnesota residents to cover advance care planning services. Defines advance care planning services as a discussion between a health professional and a patient about the patient's health care wishes if the patient becomes unable to make decisions about care.

This section is effective January 1, 2023, and applies to health plans offered, sold, issued, or renewed on or after that date.

2 Advance care planning services.

Adds subd. 3i to § 256B.0625. Requires medical assistance to cover advance care planning services.

This section is effective January 1, 2023.

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
