HF866 34th Street Reconstruction – Slayton, MN (pop. 1990)

- Seeking funding for the complete reconstruction (predesign, design, engineering, and construction) of 34th Street in Slayton from Juniper Avenue to 160th Avenue.
 - 4,200 feet (0.8 miles)
 - Reconstruction design is for a 10-ton concrete road with the addition of (2) 4-foot shoulders for pedestrian/traffic safety.
 - Arterial residential/commercial/agricultural connection between TH267 and US HWY 59

- Total estimated project cost is \$5.0 million.
 - \$2.5 State GO bond funding
 - \$1.5 million in City GO bond funding
 - \$1.0 million in special assessment revenue

- **SF338** (Weber)
 - \$2.5 GO bond request
 - No hearing in 2023
 - **Senate Capital Investment committee tour October 2023**

- **HF866** (Schomacker)
 - \$2.5 GO bond request
 - No hearing in 2023
 - **House Capital Investment committee tour October 2023**
 - Was included in final House bonding bill draft in 2024

- First requests for State bond funding were in 2023
- Project is unable to be phased as scope is only 0.8 miles and City wants to minimize traffic disruption and residential access issues during construction.
