HF866 34th Street Reconstruction – Slayton, MN (pop. 1990)

- Seeking funding for the complete reconstruction (predesign, design, engineering, and construction) of 34th Street in Slayton from Juniper Avenue to 160th Avenue.
 - o 4,200 feet (0.8 miles)
 - Reconstruction design is for a 10-ton concrete road with the addition of (2) 4-foot shoulders for pedestrian/traffic safety.
 - Arterial residential/commercial/agricultural connection between TH267 and US HWY 59
- Total estimated project cost is \$5.0 million.
 - o \$2.5 State GO bond funding
 - o \$1.5 million in City GO bond funding
 - o \$1.0 million in special assessment revenue
- **SF338** (Weber)
 - o \$2.5 GO bond request
 - o No hearing in 2023
 - o Senate Capital Investment committee tour October 2023
- HF866 (Schomacker)
 - o \$2.5 GO bond request
 - o No hearing in 2023
 - **Ouse Capital Investment committee tour October 2023**
 - o Was included in final House bonding bill draft in 2024
- First requests for State bond funding were in 2023
- Project is unable to be phased as scope is only 0.8 miles and City wants to minimize traffic disruption and residential access issues during construction.
