Summary

This bill adds soybean oil to the set of agricultural products that can be transported under a special overweight vehicle permit for farm products. Effective August 1, 2025.

Background. The farm products special permit allows six- or seven-axle vehicles to transport authorized products at vehicle weights that are higher than the limits set in state statute. The special permit is issued by a road authority (e.g., Minnesota Department of Transportation or a county) for operation on roads under its jurisdiction. Vehicle operation with the permit is subject to various limitations and requirements.
