Drinking Water | Wastewater | Storm & Sewer Improvements



The City of Fulda is undertaking a major, multi-year, multi-phased project to rebuild its water and sewer infrastructure, along with upgrading its wastewater treatment facility. This comprehensive project, which is a **once-in-70-year rebuild**, addresses aging infrastructure that is at the end of its life. The current system is causing **inefficiencies, such as excessive clean water treatment due to inflow and infiltration (I&I)**, which is costly and unnecessary.

Upgrading the infrastructure is essential to ensure compliance with environmental standards, protect public health, and meet the city's water and wastewater needs. The project will benefit the residents and businesses of Fulda, helping to preserve environmental water systems, reduce flooding, and ensure the town's long-term economic sustainability.

Project Affordability

- Population of Fulda is 1,371
- Location: Murray County, 18 miles north of Worthington
- As part of this project, the city will establish a reserve/replacement account.

- Potential increase of \$100 in utility bills per month without State Bonding

Funds Needed

Utility work will total **\$49.5 million** and will begin once funding is secured. This project includes:

- Modifications to existing Pond Treatment System
- Upgrades to Wastewater Collection System
- Modifications to existing Water Treatment Plant
- Rehabilitation of existing Water Tower
- Replacement of watermains
- Replace street and storm in areas of reconstruction
