I would hope to see key state departments involved as well such as those involved with transportation, housing and housing finance, health, human services, commerce, and special councils relating to disabilities, especially visual and auditory disabilities. Broad representation will ensure that all sectors and areas of Minnesota are considered and addressed in our Healthy Aging Plan– metro and non-metro area. Minnesota has led the country in awareness for the need to provide care and support particularly for those in physical and financial need. I love this State because it cares about its people – all of us. But now is not the time to let our guard down. Minnesota needs to consider and plan for our future. We will be the better for it and continue to be a great place to live and grow, no matter our age or limitations.
