1.5	Section 1. MINNESOTA-MADE FERTILIZER GRANT PROGRAM.
1.6	(a) The commissioner of agriculture must establish and implement the Minnesota-made
1.7	fertilizer grant program. The commissioner may award a grant of up to \$ to an applicant
1.8	to manufacture, process, and handle fertilizer while operating in Minnesota. The goal of
1.9	the grant program is to increase the supply of fertilizer produced locally.
