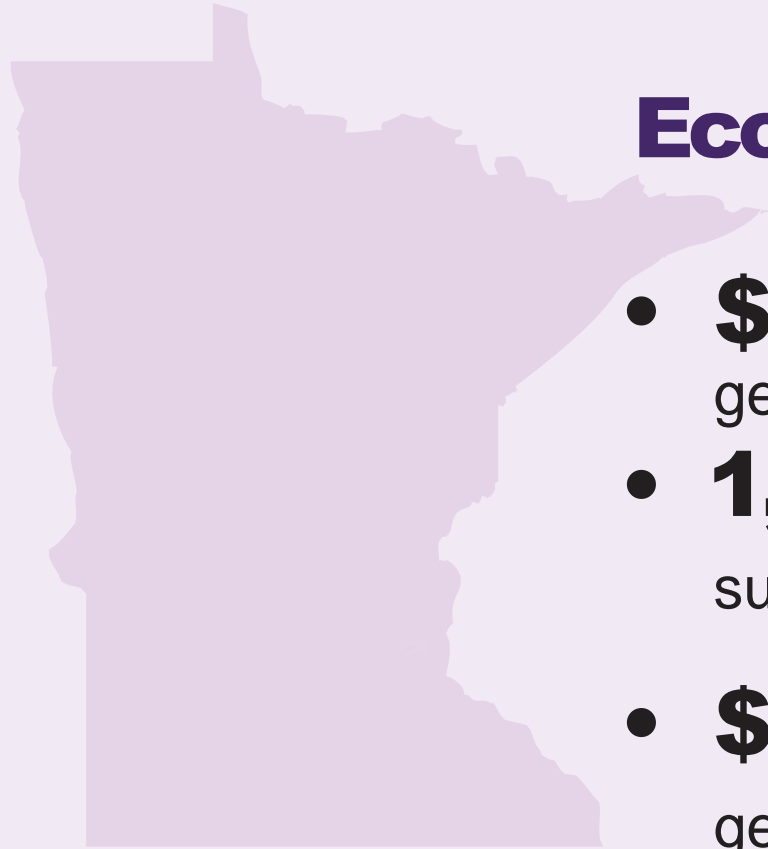

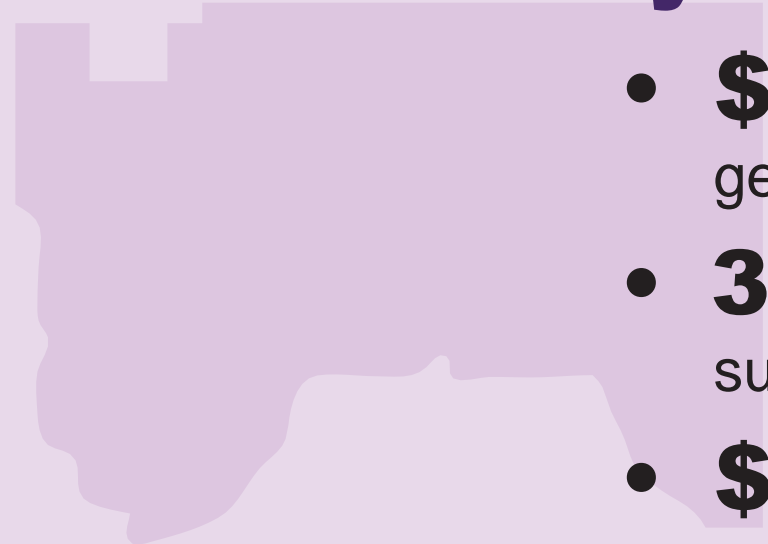
Minnesota Economic Impact
