

SUPPORT HOUSE FILE 2583

House File 2583 appropriates funds from the general fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development to award a grant to three culturally specific organizations, Minnesota Community of African People with Disabilities (MNCAPD), Roots Connect, and Fortune Relief and Youth Empowerment Organization (FRAYEO) who have been working on a grassroots level in the community. The grant's purpose is to provide workforce development activities for at-risk youth from low-income families and unengaged young adults experiencing disabilities.

We will use the grant proceeds for job readiness training, on-the-job training opportunities, support services, and mentorship and networking opportunities for the underserved youth & young adults
