## **Overview**

The bill provides a sales tax exemption for state fair admissions, parking at the State Fairgrounds, and for separately ticketed events occurring during the state fair.

The bill additionally raises the State Agricultural Society's debt limitation from \$30,000,000 to \$50,000,000.

# **Section Description**

#### 1 Bonding authority.

Raises the State Agricultural Society's debt limit for state fair bonds from \$30,000,000 to \$50,000,000.

Effective July 1, 2025.

## 2 State Agricultural Society sales at state fairs.

Provides a sales tax exemption for:

- state fair admissions and parking at the State Fairgrounds; and
- admissions for separately ticketed events run by the State Agricultural Society.

The exemption is limited to sales occurring during the regularly scheduled state fair.

Effective for sales and purchase after June 30, 2025.
