34.18       clock hours are listed in Minnesota Statutes, section 148E.130, subdivision 1.

34.19          Subd. 6. **Obsolete section.** This subdivision repeals an obsolete section. The task force  
34.20       in Minnesota Statutes, section 245.4902, expired on January 1, 2025, pursuant to Minnesota  
34.21       Statutes, section 245.4902, subdivision 6. The Department of Human Services was consulted  
34.22       in the preparation of this section.

34.23          Subd. 7. **Obsolete subdivision.** This subdivision repeals an obsolete subdivision. Laws  
34.24       2024, chapter 80, article 2, section 66, removed the background study language in Minnesota  
34.25       Statutes, section 245A.16, subdivision 3, and the corresponding amendment was never made  
34.26       to Minnesota Statutes, section 245C.11, subdivision 4.

34.27          Subd. 8. **Obsolete subdivision.** Minnesota Statutes, section 275.71, subdivision 5,  
34.28       referred to a section repealed by Laws 2023, chapter 64, article 4, section 33.

34.29          Subd. 9. **Obsolete subdivision.** Minnesota Statutes, section 469.177, subdivision 1e,  
34.30       expired December 31, 2021.

34.31          Subd. 10. **Obsolete subdivision.** Minnesota Statutes, section 473.4465, subdivision 5,  
34.32       expired according to Laws 2023, chapter 68, article 4, section 123, subdivision 11.

35.1 Subd. 11. **Obsolete subdivision.** Minnesota Statutes, section 473J.09, subdivision 14,  
35.2 related to a section repealed by Laws 2023, chapter 64, article 13, section 18.

35.3 Subd. 12. **Obsolete section.** Minnesota Statutes, section 473J.14, related to a section  
35.4 repealed by Laws 2024, chapter 85, section 115. The repealed section was required to put  
35.5 Minnesota Statutes, section 473J.14, into effect.

35.6 Subd. 13. **Conflict resolution.** This subdivision resolves a conflict between two enacted  
35.7 laws. Minnesota Statutes, section 260.762, subdivision 2, was amended by Laws 2024,  
35.8 chapter 115, article 12, section 5. That statute was also repealed by Laws 2024, chapter 115,  
35.9 article 17, section 9. The repeal was published in the main text of Minnesota Statutes, and  
35.10 the amendment was published as a note. This repealer allows the revisor to remove the note  
35.11 containing the amendatory language.

35.12 Subd. 14. **Conflict resolution.** This section resolves a conflict between two enacted  
35.13 laws. Minnesota Statutes, section 326.10, subdivision 8, was amended by Laws 2024, chapter  
35.14 120, article 3, section 3, by adding paragraph (b) to the subdivision. Minnesota Statutes,  
35.15 section 326.10, subdivision 8, was also amended in Laws 2024, chapter 121, article 4, section  
35.16 7, which added paragraph (b) to the subdivision. Because the two amendments could not  
35.17 be merged editorially, the later enacted amendment, the chapter 121 amendment, was printed
