

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 1306 as follows:

1.2 Page 1, after line 6, insert:

1.3 "Section 1. [473.4075] TRANSIT SAFETY REPORTING.

1.4 (a) By February 15 annually, the council must submit a report on transit safety and
1.5 administrative citations to the members and staff of the legislative committees with
1.6 jurisdiction over transportation policy and finance.

1.7 (b) At a minimum, the report must:

1.8 (1) provide an overview of transit safety issues and actions taken by the council to
1.9 improve safety;

1.10 (2) provide an overview of administrative citations under section 609.855, subdivision
1.11 8, including a summary of implementation and analysis of impacts of the program on fare
1.12 compliance and customer experience for riders;

1.13 (3) for each of the previous three calendar years, provide data and statistics on:

1.14 (i) crime rates occurring on public transit vehicles and transit stops and stations;

1.15 (ii) the number of warnings and criminal citations issued by the Metropolitan Transit
1.16 Police, with a breakout by categorized reasons for a warning or citation; and

1.17 (iii) the number of administrative citations issued, with a breakout by issuance by peace
1.18 officers, community service officers, and other authorized nonsworn personnel;

1.19 (4) for each of the previous three calendar years, state the number of peace officers
1.20 employed by the Metropolitan Transit Police Department;

1.21 (5) state the average number of peace officers employed by the Metropolitan Transit
1.22 Police Department for the previous three calendar years; and

- 2.1 (6) make recommendations on how to improve safety on public transit and transit stops
- 2.2 and stations, and for legislative changes, if any."
- 2.3 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references
- 2.4 Amend the title accordingly
