
City of Wayzata Lakefront & Public Space Project

PROJECT COST SUMMARY

Phase 1 - \$10 Mil (Completed)

Funded by the City (85%) & Three Rivers Park District (15%)
Components: Lake Street, Plaza Park, Railroad Safety Enhancements, Dakota Rail Regional
Trail Extension

Phase 2 - \$11.5 Mil (Completed)

Funded by the City (56%), State Bonds (35%), and The Wayzata Conservancy (9%) Components: Lakeshore Restoration, Lakewalk, Community Docks

Final Phase - \$15 Mil

Proposed Funding by State Bonds supported by The Wayzata Conservancy and matching funds from the City. Components: Historic Section Foreman House Rehabilitation, Eco Park including interactive STEAM classroom, Depot Park Accessibility Improvements and Public Restroom, Wayzata Beach, Klapprich Park Accessibility Improvements, Lakeshore Restoration, Design of adjacent Public Safety Facility





STATUS UPDATE

Phase 1 & 2 - Substaintially complete. Phase 2 opened Summer 2024.

Final Phase - Construction to begin after funding is secured.
