## Summary

School districts must provide students enrolled in kindergarten through eighth grade with age-appropriate active transportation safety training. The training for students in kindergarten through third grade must include pedestrian safety (Minnesota Statutes, section 123B.935, subdivision 1, paragraph (a)), while the training for students in grades four through eight must include additional components (Minnesota Statutes, section 123B.935, subdivision 1, paragraph (b)).

This bill repeals the deadlines for schools to provide the required active transportation safety training. The deadlines depend on the student's grade band and date of enrollment.
