**EXPLANATION OF THE BILL**

The bill would exempt materials and supplies used or consumed in and equipment incorporated into the construction, reconstruction, upgrade, expansion, renovation, or remodeling of a regional exhibition center and site improvements at Graham Park in Olmsted County. The exemption would be administered as a refund and apply to purchases made after December 31, 2024, and before January 1, 2028.

**REVENUE ANALYSIS DETAIL**

- The estimate is based on project information provided by Olmsted County.
- The total project cost is estimated to be \$39.0 million.
- The total cost of materials is estimated to be \$15.6 million.
- The project will begin in August 2025 and complete in June 2027. The distribution of expected refund claims is assumed based on the project timeline.
