The bill expands the crime of criminal sexual conduct in the fourth degree to include the case where a person who is employed at a secure treatment facility has sexual contact with a resident of the secure treatment facility. Consent by the victim is not a defense.

Minnesota Statutes, section 253B.02, subdivision 18a, defines "secure treatment facility" to include the Minnesota Security Hospital at St. Peter and the Minnesota Sex Offender program at Moose Lake.
