Overview

This bill establishes a grant program to encourage family outreach services. Makes a school district or charter school eligible for a grant if the school: has been designated a low-performing school; has a student population with more than twice the state average number of low-income students; or has rapidly changing student demographics. Requires a school to make a local match in order to receive a grant.

Limits the grant amount to no more than \$50,000 per year per site. Requires a grant recipient to contract with a provider of targeted family outreach services to provide the services.

- **Targeted family outreach services.** Establishes a grant program to encourage family outreach services. Sets eligibility criteria and limits grants to no more than \$50,000 per site per year.
- **Appropriations.** Appropriates an unspecified amount of money in fiscal years 2012 and 2013 to the commissioner of education for purposes of making targeted family outreach service grants.
