Subject: Aggregate tax in the city of Vergas

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Provides that if Otter Tail County does not impose the aggregate materials (gravel) tax, authorized by statute, then the city of Vergas may impose the tax in the city instead. The proceeds of the tax would be used for the same purpose as the county tax: 85 percent for roads and bridges, and 15 percent for pit and quarry restoration or other conservation or environmental needs. The city tax would be repealed if Otter Tail County started to impose a gravel tax.

Similar authority has been authorized three times in the past:

- For 14 townships in St. Louis County (imposed in 6);
- For Sylvan Township in Cass County (never imposed, authority expired); and
- For Scambler Township in Otter Tail County
