Summary

This bill classifies specified governmental data on users of shared mobility services (such as Uber and Lyft as well as scooter rental companies) as private data on individuals, which has the effect of making the information not public but still accessible by the subject of the data. The data being classified includes personally identifiable information and account data for the mobility service.
