1 Appropriation.

Appropriates \$1,000,000 in fiscal years 2024 and 2025 to the commissioner of public safety to fund a violence prevention project research center dedicated to reducing violence in society through the use of data and analysis to improve policy and practice in Minnesota. Requires the center to place an emphasis on issues related to gun violence.
