Overview

This bill authorizes local units of government that employ peace officers to share data with the Peace Officer Standards and Training Board (POST) when the board is investigating a peace officer for misconduct.

| 1 | <p>Data to be shared with board.</p> <p>Directs local government officials to cooperate with the POST Board when provided notice that the board is investigating a peace officer. Local officials must provide the board with public, private, and confidential data related to the peace officer who is the subject of the board's investigation. Requires local officials to notify the board when a peace officer was discharged for misconduct.</p> |
| 2 | <p>Immunity from liability.</p> <p>Grants immunity from civil and criminal penalties under the data practices chapter for local officials who comply with the data sharing and notice requirements in section 1.</p> |
