## Summary

This bill would repeal the Driver and Vehicle Systems Oversight Committee. The legislature established this joint committee in 2019 to oversee the Department of Public Safety's decommissioning of the Minnesota Licensing and Registration System (MNLARS) and implementation of the replacement Vehicle Title and Registration System (VTRS).

The 2019 law did not include a specific expiration, or "sunset," date for the oversight committee. Instead, the law provided that the oversight committee would expire six months after full implementation of VTRS. According to the Office of the Legislative Auditor, DPS and Minnesota Information Technology Services (MNIT) completed the VTRS program and related projects in February 2022.

According to the Legislative Coordinating Commission, the oversight committee last met in November 2021.
