Subject Prescription drug rebates

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Overview

This bill requires a pharmacy benefit manager (PBM) and a health carrier to use any prescription drug rebates from a drug manufacturer to reduce costs for covered persons associated with the drug.

Summary

Section Description

1 Responsibility to use compensation for benefit of covered persons.

Establishes § 62W.16.

Subd. 1. Compensation used to reduce point-of-sale costs. Provides that a PBM or a health carrier must remit all compensation received from a drug manufacturer for a prescription drug to the covered person associated with the particular drug, unless the person's cost-sharing obligation for the drug is less than what the person would pay for the drug after the application of the compensation from the drug manufacturer.

Subd. 2. Definitions. Defines terms for use in the section.

Subd. 3. Report on compliance. Beginning March 1, 2026, and annually thereafter, requires that a PBM and a health carrier report to the commissioner of human services on how they have complied with the section.

Makes the section effective January 1, 2026.

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
