Subject Missing and Endangered Persons Program

Summary

This bill adds persons with dementia, a traumatic brain injury, Alzheimer's disease, or other cognitive impairments to the scope of the missing and endangered persons program. If someone with one of the noted conditions goes missing and law enforcement believes they are at risk of physical injury or death, an alert shall be issued. Endangered Missing Person Alerts are issued by local law enforcement agencies or the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension (BCA) will issue an alert at a local agency's request.

When an alert is issued, it will include a description of the missing person and information on how citizens can help find them.
