

**Subject** Family supportive housing grant program established

## Overview

This bill establishes the family supportive housing grant program and lays out requirements for eligibility, administration, and eligible uses of funds; and appropriates money for the grant program.

## Summary

Section Description

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**1 Family supportive housing grant program.**

Establishes the family supportive housing grant program and lays out requirements for eligibility, administration, and eligible uses of funds.

**Subd. 1. Establishment; purpose.** Requires the commissioner of human services to establish a family supportive housing grant program to award competitive grants to eligible applicants operating supportive housing for families.

**Subd. 2. Definitions.** For purposes of this section, defines the terms “family,” “family permanent supportive housing,” and “resident.”

**Subd. 3. Eligibility.** Requires an applicant for a grant under this section to be a nonprofit organization or Tribal government operating family permanent supportive housing.

**Subd. 4. Application and administration.** Requires each applicant to include the number of families they estimate to serve when applying to the commissioner for a grant. Specifies how grant funds must be administered. By June 30, 2026, requires each grantee to provide a report to the commissioner on how many families the grantee served and what services the grantee provided.

**Subd. 5. Eligible uses of grant money.** Requires grant recipients to use grant funds for the services described in subdivision 6.

Section	Description
	<b>Subd. 6. Specialized family support services.</b> Describes specialized family support services and lists services that may be provided.
2	<b>Appropriation; family supportive housing grant program.</b> Appropriates an unspecified amount in fiscal year 2026 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for the family supportive housing grant program. Specifies this is a onetime appropriation and is available until June 30, 2027.



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
