Overview

This bill creates a task force to study and write a report on the availability and affordability of housing in Minnesota that is accessible to individuals with a disability.

Summary

Section Description

1 Accessible Housing Task Force.

Creates a task force to look at the experience of individuals who have disabilities related to finding housing designed to assist individuals with disabilities to live independently, including challenges that prevent landlords from providing accessible housing options.

This bill provides membership for the task force and requires the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency to provide space and assistance for the task force and to begin the first meeting no later than August 15, 2025.

The task force must write an initial report to the legislature by February 1, 2026, that gives recommendations for improving the supply, quality, and affordability of housing for individuals with disabilities who need changes for independent living, and then the task force must write a final report no later than August 31, 2026.

2 Appropriation; Accessible Housing Task Force.

Provides an appropriation to the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency for the Accessible Housing Task Force.
