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## **Overview**

This bill requires the commissioner of human services to establish a new consumer-directed community supports (CDCS) budget exception for persons with both developmental disabilities and type 1 diabetes.

Individuals receiving medical assistance (MA) disability waiver services who choose the CDCS option receive a state-set limit for individual budgets and allowable services/expenses. CDCS is an option under the MA waivers that provides a person with more choice and responsibility in managing his or her: (1) services and supports; and (2) budget allocation. A financial management services provider helps the person with financial and employer-related tasks.

## Section Description

Budget exception for persons with developmental disabilities and type 1 diabetes. Amends § 256B.4911, by adding subd. 4a. Requires the commissioner to establish a new CDCS budget exception under the MA disability waivers for persons with both developmental disabilities and type 1 diabetes. Requires the amount of the exception to be equal to nine hours per day at the current rate for home care nursing provided by a registered nurse at the time of application for the budget exception.

Makes this section effective January 1, 2026, or upon federal approval, whichever is later. Requires the commissioner of human services to notify the revisor of statutes when federal approval is obtained.

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
