Overview

School districts are required to adopt local health standards. In 2024, the legislature required the Department of Education to develop state health standards. The standards development process is underway, and the rulemaking period is expected to begin in 2026. The 2024 session law requires the health standards to include expectations for learning that are currently required under state law, including cannabis use and substance use education.

This bill requires the substance use education to include overdose recognition, prevention, and response education.
