Summary

This bill transfers \$900,000 in each fiscal year of the 2026-2027 biennium from the general fund to the housing development fund and makes the transfer ongoing each fiscal year thereafter; appropriates \$900,000 in each fiscal year of the 2026-2027 biennium from the housing development fund to the commissioner of the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency for a grant to the Wilder Foundation for the Minnesota homeless study, and specifies how the appropriation must be disbursed; and allows the commissioner to use up to one percent of the appropriation for administrative costs. The bill also requires the Wilder Foundation to submit a copy of the Minnesota homeless study and a report that summarizes the findings of the study to the legislative committees with jurisdiction over housing and homelessness by March 1, 2028, and every three years thereafter.
