Summary

This bill broadens the situations where a vehicle bearing dealer plates can be operated, to authorize use of the vehicle as a courtesy vehicle when various conditions are met. Among the requirements, the driver cannot be an employee of the dealer and the vehicle must be:

- offered as part of repair or service on another vehicle;
- provided at minimal or no cost; and
- conspicuously identified as a courtesy vehicle.
