## **Overview**

This bill expands the allowable delivery systems for epinephrine in schools from only auto-injectors to include other delivery systems such as inhalers. It also requires the commissioner of health to provide a district or school with a standing order for distribution of epinephrine delivery systems; schools can currently access naloxone through a standing order and condition-specific protocol.

Under a standing order developed with a licensed prescriber, an eligible organization, such as a school, may purchase, administer, and distribute a prescription drug under circumstances specified in the standing order. A condition-specific protocol allows a prescription drug to be administered by an authorized person, such as a nurse, when a person's condition falls within an established protocol that does not reference a specific patient. The protocol provides direction on why, when, and how to administer the prescription drug.
